\*On admission a new Member becomes liable for the full amount of the Entrance Fee but by concession this may be paid over a period of up to 5 years interest free.

Resignation from Membership does not release a Member from liability for any part of the Entrance Fee unpaid at the date of resignation.

### 3. Playing Guests

Members are entitled to introduce 15 guests at the concessionary rate of £7 per person, thereafter a reduced rate of £10 per guest.

Members must have their Fixture Diary to hand otherwise the charge is £10.

Appropriate rebate(s) may be claimed from the Professional or Secretary on production of the Fixture Diary and the relevant green fee receipt(s).

### 4. Booking Tee Off Times

Bookings are made through the Professional. Tee off times are controlled by a booking sheet system. Red times may be booked seven days in advance. Black times may be booked on the day of play only and not before 8.00am. Red and Black times alternate i.e. 8.00am Red, 8.08am Black, 8.16am Red and so on.

### 5. Competitions

There are a number of monthly medals throughout the year. Your Fixture Diary will give full details. Weekend medals are balloted and the ballot sheet will come out 2 weeks before the medal day, in the Professional's shop from 8.00am. Members should enter their names in one of the half-hourly groups and after entry to the competition closes, entries can then be accepted either in person or by telephone. A draw will be made 3 days before the medal day and will be available in the Professional's shop. There are also the Club's knock-out competitions which are drawn every year in March. Annual Subscriptions must be renewed by the stated date in order to be eligible to enter the competitions.

### 6. Handicaps

New Members who have an existing handicap must provide a handicap certificate which should be handed into the office for the attention of the Match and Handicap Convenor. New Members without a current handicap should lodge 3 scores off the Yellow Tees – these scores must be marked by a Member with an official handicap. New members should also confirm their 'home' club, for handicapping purposes, if they are members of more than one golf club. In order to maintain their handicap members must play in at least 3 medal competitions during each year, otherwise their handicap will lapse.

### 7. Non-Playing Guests

Members inviting non-playing guests into the Clubhouse must complete the details in the register of non-playing guests, situated in the Clubhouse Entrance Hall, and accompany their guests at all times.

### 8. Grievances

Any grievances should be submitted in writing to the Secretary.
