NOTES FOR THE GUIDANCE OF VISITING PARTIES

GREEN FEES

The Green Fees are **£35.00** per round and **£50.00** per day: 1 April – 31 October and **£20** per round: 1 November – 31 March.

A deposit of £10 per player is required for a reservation to be confirmed and careful note should be made of the conditions of reservation and deposit specified on the booking form. *(10% discount for returning parties – see below)**

The balance of the green fees should be paid to the Club Secretary 7 days in advance of the day of play or, alternatively, to the Club Professional on the day of play itself.

Payment in advance by cheque/cash/credit card/switch (Payment by Credit Card carries a 5% surcharge to cover bank charges).

Please make cheques payable to Cardross Golf Club.

LIST OF VISITORS

In accordance with licensing laws, it is necessary for the Club to display a separate list of names and addresses of all visitors to whom the courtesy of the course and clubhouse has been granted. **(The address of each visitor could be a central address i.e. office)**

This information should be submitted to the Club Secretary 7 days prior to the day of play.

Dress Code

Members and Visitors are expected to dress in a neat, tidy and appropriate manner.

*When on the course visitors **must** wear proper golf shoes (this is a Health & Safety requirement)*

In particular the following items may

NOT

be worn on the course :

Jeans or denim materials

(Jeans are permitted in the Family Lounge only)

T-shirts

Collarless or sleeveless tops (men)

Golf turtle-neck tops are permitted

Tracksuit/shellsuit tops or trousers/

Cargo/Combat trousers

Non-tailored shorts

(Tailored shorts)

Football/rugby tops or club colours/emblems

on clothing or equipment

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In addition

golf shoes and hats may not be worn in the clubhouse

(other than in the locker rooms)

Trainers are permitted in the Family Lounge only.

In the case of Juniors, trainers worn on the course should not be worn in the Clubhouse.

Anyone in breach of this Dress Code

will be asked to leave the course or Clubhouse

BASIC RULES TO REMEMBER

DON'T

- talk, move, stand close to or distract a player.
- lay a golf bag on, or pull a caddy car across, a green.
- pull a caddy car across a teeing ground.
- lean on your putter on the green.
- take practice swings on the tee.

DO

- repair any damage to the course (divots, plug marks, rake bunkers etc.).
- lay the flag stick at the side of the green.
- leave rakes IN a bunker.
- take caddy cars around the green (outside the line of the bunkers – or follow signs)

NEVER across the greens.

- use the correct tee.
- avoid slow play. If you lose one clear hole on the game in front, invite the next match through. Wave the next match through if you lose a ball and it is not easily found. Don't wait 5 minutes before so doing.
- make sure that the players in front are out of range before you play your shot.
- leave the green immediately. Mark your card on the next tee.
- be aware, at all times, of the need for safety on the course. Shout 'FORE' if players are endangered by your ball.
- remember that you are always an ambassador of the Club. Please read, and comply with, Club rules regarding acceptable dress, conduct and procedures.
- remember that you are responsible for learning the Rules of Golf.
- accept that you are responsible for the conduct of your guests.
